

Monochrome Print Interclub Competition

For the “Jack Skeel Trophies”

Rules

1. The Competition will be held annually by Wight Balance Photography Plus.
2. The Competition is open to any Photographic or Camera Club based on the Isle of Wight.
3. The Competition will be for Monochrome Prints Only.
4. Definition of Monochrome (FIAP) A black and white image fitting from the very dark grey (black) to the very light grey (white) is a monochrome image with a various shades of grey. A black and white image which has been modified by the addition of a single tone to the ENTIRE image is defined as a monochrome image.

On the other hand a black and white image modified by a partial toning or by the addition of one colour becomes a colour image (polychrome) and will not be accepted into the competition.

5. Prints must not be more than THREE YEARS old.
6. A maximum of THREE IMAGES are permitted from any one person.
7. No person can enter images for more than one club.
8. The competition is divided into two separate Competitions.

Competition One is the Interclub Competition

9. The winner is the club that scores the highest accumulative score.
10. Each club will enter a maximum of ten images.
11. Each image will be identified on the back of the image with the Title of the work, the Name of the author, and the Club it represents.
12. Each image will be marked / scored by a Judge appointed by Wight Balance Photography Plus.
13. The Judge will be if possible from the Southern Photographic Federation Panel of “A” listed Judges or Independent from clubs taking part.
14. The Judge will award a maximum of 10 points for each image.
15. The club with the highest accumulative score is the winner.
16. Should there be a draw then the club with the highest number of highest scoring images will be the winner.
17. The “Jack Skeel Monochrome Interclub Trophy” will be awarded to the winners of Competition One

Competition Two for Individual Photographers

18. Competition Two is for the best print in the competition.
19. Only images entered into Competition One will be eligible to be entered into Competition Two

20. The Judge will select from all the images that have been entered into Competition One and select from them the best image of the whole competition.

21. The “Jack Skeel Monochrome Best in Competition Trophy” will be awarded to the winner of Competition Two.

22. The winners of the Trophies will hold them for ONE YEAR and return them to Wight Balance Photography Plus in time for presentation the following years’ competition..

23. The Trophies remain the property of the Wight Balance Photography Plus.
